Worship

Love it Bible based Relevant to the times and topical Needs to be relevant to youth

Developing relationships with God

The importance of small groups including bible studies, Alpha, coffee hour and prayer Teaching at all levels including Sunday School Support each other as in the journey

Building Community with each other

More comments regarding the importance and diversity of small groups

Serving in the church

Continue to encourage volunteers and have creative recruitment Need personal invitations and short-term opportunities Encourage youth and L.I.T.s to build confidence

Outreach and Missions in our community and the world

Food cupboard, Explorers and Indigenous Events are good examples Build on past efforts Use of meals to get people together We miss the CMHA dinners on Hamilton Road

Children

The staff is doing a good job Sunday School, Explorers, VBS

Youth

Need more leaders Look at why youth consider church unsafe Need to find ways to keep youth

Young Adults

Not active

Need to have activities and leaders

Families

Need to have suitable activities Opportunities to be involved

Seniors

Keep supporting seniors (phone list, internet, volunteers) More programs and dinners

Discipleship

Having small groups helps Alpha is affective Need to train leaders Need to be relevant and open to the community Train how to engage meaningfully with newcomers
